Access Controls International Offers Our RoofGuard Local Alarm System

May 30, 2000, New York – Access Controls International, a leading developer of security technology systems and products, is now offering its RoofGuard Local Alarm System. Since fire and emergency exit safety codes prohibit the locking of roof exit doors, these areas have become a target for security and safety violations. Furthermore, unsupervised rooftop door landings and upper stairwells often attract loiterers. ACI has designed the unique, self-contained RoofGuard Alarm System to provide safety and security for all stairwell and rooftop applications.

RoofGuard is typically installed at the highest point in stairwell and continuously monitors the upper stairwell, access landing, and door egress. Each RoofGuard system is comprised of a closed and open circuit solid-state alarm board incorporating siren driver, alarm cut-off timer, timer for arming/shunting, and battery charging network. Each system also contains a siren speaker, rechargeable battery, passive infrared sensor, walk test light, and a remote control shunting receiver.

The system components are housed in a durable, vandal-resistant enclosure, equipped with tamper switches at each access panel. This alarm is interfaced with building power through a low voltage transformer, and is backed-up by a 4.0 ampere hour rechargeable battery. A mini remote transmitter is used for passage by authorized personnel. When activating the shunt, the alarm shuts down and automatically rearms in a specific time frame.
